Helpful Tips for Using Meet Manager, Team Manager, and Team Unify Software

Updated June 11, 2024

This working document is to help troubleshoot the issues of moving from paper and pencil to using Team Management Software (Team Manager/TeamUnify) and Meet Manager.

- Team Manager product you must purchase from Hy-Tek
 - This is for Meet Entries ONLY
- Team Manager Lite free product but limited use
 - This is for Meet Entries ONLY
- TeamUnify product you must purchase from TeamUnify
 - o This is for running your entire Team (including a website) & Meet Entries
- Meet Manager product you can download from the league or purchase your own
 - This is for running the Meet ONLY

Team & Meet Manager do not work with MAC computers currently. You must use a PC.

Meet Files:

Are you using the templates from the Delco League Site – if not please be using those files we have recently updated them.

Communication:

From home team to visiting team by Wednesday the week of your meet is a must. If you move your Meet to a different day please reach out a min. of 2 days ahead of time.

Home Team

- Use the Template from the Delco League Site to create the meet in Meet Manager
- From Meet Manager you create a Team Enty File you would export this file from Meet Manager as a zip file. Save this file so you can email it to the Rep & Head Coach of who you are swimming.
- Doing this step means that BOTH teams will be using the same meet file to create their entries and cuts down on any potential errors
- DO NOT use an old file every meet download a new file to create the meet you are swimming. Using old files could lead to the program malfunctioning while in use and

you could lose all data you input. This has happened many times before. Good practice is during the meet to back up the meet so the information is saved.

Visiting Team

- o Import the meet file from the Home team into your Team Management Software
 - Please wait to get the file from the Home Team to ensure success at the meet
- Create your entries in your Team Management Software
 - In TeamUnify you can not assign heat and lanes
 - In Team Manager you should be assigning heats and lanes to your swimmers
- Bring your laptop you have the entries on to the meet. You must have a jump drive that you export them onto so you can upload them to the host team computer. Do not assume there is wifi for you to use.

Both Teams

- Must communicate about the following:
 - Do you plan to print at the meet or must you bring copies with you
 - Eligibility List 2 copies min.
 - Lineups 2 copies for the table plus whatever you need for coaches/volunteers.
 - You must fill out your cards prior to the meet.
 - Exhibition
 - This is helpful for teams that have large age groups to know if they are using just their lanes or could they use all lanes for exhibition heat.

At the meet & after the meet:

- The paper copy of results and the computer must MATCH.
 - o Reasons why they might not match could be:
 - Error in hand scoring
 - Giving all points to one team (each team can only score 2 swimmers max)
 - Place Judges differ from the times inputted in the computer to fix a place over time you must use the Judges Decision Button in Meet Manager to override the times – example of this will be at the end of this document.
- The results from Meet Manager will be the official results as that is the information that is posted on the league website.
- You MUST enter DQ codes in Meet Manager
 - This information is helpful for the swimmer/coach to review after the meet.
- Please send results as a PDF as a single column
- Exhibition Swimmers must be marked Exhibition in Meet Manager. From the Run Screen there is a column called EX make sure the box is checked.
 - Teams using Team Manager for Entries you can also check this box when doing entries, so it is already done for the scorers at the meet.
 - If this is not done when you score the event you could have 7 or more swimmers eligible for points when we only score the Live Heat in each Event.
- If you are running Meet Manager alongside the paper copy before you leave the meet, please email the meet results with the scores include example is below you can see at the end of the link the combined team scores are shown.


JV is a great chance to use Meet Manager and train parents to use the technology.

Small x – that is for the 3^{rd} swimmer from a team that CANNOT score as you cannot sweep an event.

Large X – that is for those swimmers that are exhibition.

Also, in this race since Ridley Township only has 2 live swimmers, they didn't have a small x for any swimmers.



DQ Codes, Athlete/Relay Points, & Comined Team Scores ONLY (don't need Male/Female)




If you need to add a new athlete to your team – please click on Athletes




Please click on Add




If you have a swimmer on your team that is no longer swimming and you wish to delete them but don't want to lose the data, please just click on INACTIVE.







When entering in Team Manager – see below for a live and exhibition swimmer

- Live Swimmer Payton Nelson Heat 1 / Lane 4
 - Click entrd column, type in 1 in Heat, type in 4 in LN
- Exhibition Swimmer Parker Nelson Heat 2 / Lane 2
 - O Click entrd column, Click Exhib, type in 2 in Heat, type in 2 in LN





In Team Manager to Export Meet Entries or Meet Results you click on File, Export, then select what you would like to Export



Making sure IDs are the same from TeamUnify and Team Manager if using both programs

Copy Both IDs

- Old one from Team Manager
- New one from TeamUnify

Paste into word

Then in TeamUnify click on merge ID under the swimmer

Paste the OLD ID and then pastes the NEW ID

This is for teams with USA Swimmers that the ID is not the DOB anymore and TeamUnify has picked up the new ID.

If you search in TeamUnify for Meet Results and you have a kid in BLUE that means the IDs are wrong and those times won't be stored under the swimmer until you fix the IDs.
